



The Traveling Teacher 2026–2027 Tuition & Fees Policy

Personalized learning pod tuition begins at **\$80 per day**. Step Up for Students is accepted. A full tuition schedule, fees, and payment terms are outlined below.

Tuition Schedule

Tuition is based on an annual rate of \$80 per day and may be paid in full, in quarterly installments, or in ten monthly payments from August 1, 2026 through May 1, 2027. Tuition reserves a student's place in the program for the selected schedule and is not based on attendance.

Required Fees

Enrollment Deposit

A \$400 non-refundable enrollment deposit is required to secure enrollment. The enrollment deposit is applied toward the student's annual tuition balance, and a child's place is not reserved until the deposit has been received.

Materials & Activity Fee

A \$450 annual materials and activity fee per student is due upon enrollment. This fee helps cover workbooks, classroom supplies, printed learning materials, manipulatives, a student t-shirt, yearbook, graduation-related items and celebrations, and other special classroom activities or program materials. This fee is non-refundable.

Discounts

- Returning families who complete enrollment, including submission of all required enrollment forms and payment of the enrollment deposit, by June 5, 2026 receive \$1,000 off annual tuition.
- A 10% sibling discount applies to tuition only for additional enrolled children.
- Only one tuition discount may be applied per student unless approved in writing.

Scholarship & Payment Notes

- Step Up for Students scholarship funding is accepted.
- Families are responsible for approving and releasing scholarship funds on time.
- Any balance, fee, deposit, or amount not covered by scholarship funds remains the family's responsibility.

Payment Options and Terms

Families may choose annual payment, four equal quarterly payments, or ten equal monthly payments due on the first of each month from August 1, 2026 through May 1, 2027.

- Tuition payments are due on the agreed-upon due dates.
- Tuition is based on enrollment, not attendance.
- No deductions, credits, or refunds are given for absences, illness, vacations, holidays, emergency closures, or family schedule changes.
- Tuition is not prorated except for approved late starters at the sole discretion of The Traveling Teacher.
- Credit and debit card payments are subject to a 3% processing fee.

Late Payments and Returned Payments

- A \$25 late fee is added to any payment not received within 5 calendar days of the due date.
- A \$50 returned payment fee is charged for any payment that is returned, declined, reversed, or unable to be processed.
- Continued late payments may place enrollment at risk and may affect re-enrollment eligibility.

Late Pick-Up Policy

Students must be picked up between 1:00 PM and 1:15 PM. Beginning at 1:16 PM, a late pick-up fee of \$1 per minute per child will apply. Late pick-up fees will be invoiced bi-weekly.

Withdrawal, Refund, and Schedule Policies

- A written 30-day notice is required for withdrawal.
- The enrollment deposit and materials & activity fee are non-refundable.
- Tuition already paid is non-refundable, and families remain responsible for tuition during the 30-day notice period.
- Withdrawal does not cancel any outstanding balances already owed.
- Requests to change a student's attendance schedule must be made in writing and are subject to availability.
- Temporary absences do not qualify as schedule changes.

Calendar, Closures, and Delinquent Accounts

- Tuition is based on the full academic program and published school calendar, not on the exact number of days attended each month.
- The school calendar includes holidays and planned closures, and tuition is not reduced for these dates.
- In the case of unexpected closures due to weather, illness, emergencies, or events beyond our control, refunds, credits, or make-up days are not guaranteed.
- If an account becomes past due, The Traveling Teacher reserves the right to suspend attendance, decline re-enrollment, release the student's spot, or require a different payment arrangement.
